Rozan was founded in 1998 by a group of volunteers with a mission for "a self-aware, gender-just society that celebrates diversity and is free of violence".

Since its inception main focus of Rozan's work remained on marginalized groups like women and children. There has been a strong understanding within the organization that men and boys have an important role to play in order to achieve the goal of gender equality. Rozan through its program "Humqadam" has conducted various researches on the issues of men and masculinities in Pakistan, developed resource material and organized training programs on masculinities and gender violence.



This is a learning course aiming to enhance i) deeper understanding on masculinities issues ii) skills to critically analyze the root causes of different forms of injustices iii) sensitivities towards the vulnerable populations of the society.

Core contents of the course:

- · Deeper understanding of masculinities
- Masculinities, gender violence and patriarchy
- · Culture, religion and masculinities
- Engaging men and boys: a mean to gender equality
- · Self. socialization and masculinities
- · Violent conflicts and masculinities
- Feminisms

Methodology of the Course:

The course methodology will be participatory and experiential. Learning techniques such as group work, plenary discussions, role plays, case studies, discussions/talks with/by experts/activists & video screening will be used.

Applicants can be human rights activists, gender trainers, academicians, researchers, media persons and students enrolled in PhD. & M. Phil. programs of social sciences disciplines.
